SHOW-AND-TELL

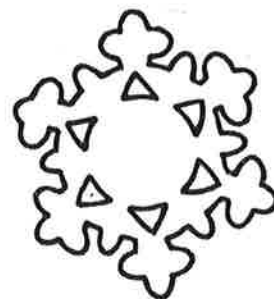
Your child may bring in one of their favorite Christmas gifts on Thursday, January 4/Friday, January 5. Each one will have an opportunity to tell something about their gift.

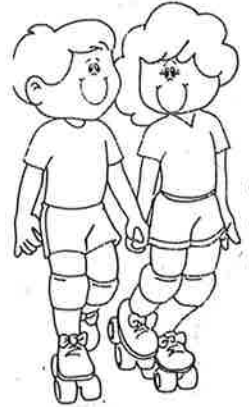
TEDDY BEAR DAY

PHONE NUMBERS

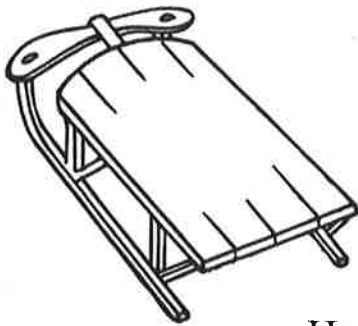
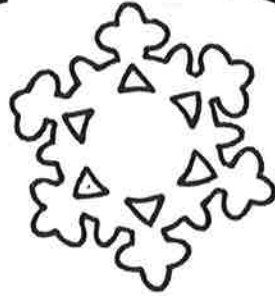
During the month of January your child will be asked to recite their phone number including the 419 or other prefix. You can begin practicing at home.
