The purpose of Outreach is to develop an evangelism consciousness, organize teams and events and coordinate nursing home outreach. Some things we have planned:

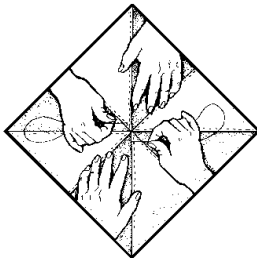
- July mission trip to Solid Rock in the Dominican Republic.

We help support several missionaries and missions. Some are a long way from home and all have given up much to work in the Lord's service.

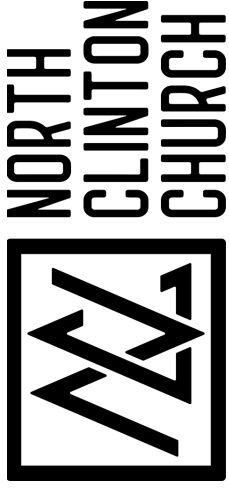
- The Nofzigers serve in Costa Rica
