- 21. STAYING CONNECTED just got easier! North Clinton uses an automated system, One Call Now, to communicate prayer requests, updates, and emergencies. We now have a NEW option to receive these messages by text. You now have the choice to receive messages by email, phone call, or text message. You will not be able to receive both a phone call and a text message. One or the other may be chosen. Please note that message and data rates may apply, and you'll need to opt-in to begin receiving messages. To opt-in send @NCtext to 22300. Sign up on the tearoff through the month of May or contact the church office to choose how you'd like to receive messages.
- 22. PLACE YOUR REQUEST for use of church facilities and equipment for ministry or personal events through the Church Office. This includes use of rooms, tables, chairs, and all moveable equipment. To give priority to ministry events, personal events will not be scheduled more than six weeks in advance of the date.
